The facility provider Gosling has arranged that suitably qualified first-aid staff are dedicated to the event and will be located at the foot of the slope during skiing.</li> <li>2. In addition, Gosling staff will be in contact by radio / telephone with Gosling Duty Manager.</li> <li>3. Gosling Duty Manager is also a qualified first aider and will be on-site although not necessarily at foot of slope.</li> <li>4. Gosling provide a stocked first aid kit and defibrillator, have advised that this is located in the ski hut at the bottom of the slope. A second defibrillator is located at the reception desk in the main building.</li> <li>5. No medication is carried.</li> <li>6. Race to be stopped immediately on incident. Officials instructed to call for first aid support using flags and radio.</li> <li>7. Gosling staff to summon Duty Manager as backup first-aid.</li> </ol>

		8. First Aider to assess whether injured can be moved from slope or not. 9. If can be moved, slope is cleared, and race restarted once backup is on site. 10. If must be left in situ then race will continue to be suspended until appropriate next level support (ambulance) attends and course is cleared. 11. Once in attendance, Gosling Duty Manager is responsible for the incident and will call Ambulance if required. 12. Chief of Championships completes accident form or notes on report.
